

CONFESSION TO A FAITHFUL GOD | NEHEMIAH 9:1-38

In the book of Nehemiah, we clearly see, God was focused on transforming the spiritual lives of the Israelites. The nation's desire to receive the Word of God as their foundation, ignited their need to respond to the Word of God in repentance.
