

CHRISTMAS STORIES | THE INEXPRESSIBLE GIFT 2 CORINTHIANS 9:15 & ADDITIONAL PASSAGES

Christmas is all about a gift! In 2nd Corinthians Paul calls our Lord Jesus "the inexpressible gift". The KJV translates it as the "unspeakable gift" and the New Living Translation as "the gift too wonderful for words". When we reflect on the "Inexpressible Gift" we learn about God's definition of love, His unchanging character, and the undeserved nature of the Gift. We learn about the resounding power of this gift and are faced with the urgency of opening this gift. We are presented with the truth that the gift of Christ should be that which motivates us to love others through the Christmas season. Let's reflect on the Inexpressible Gift!

1. The gift of Christ teaches us about His resounding power to overcome sin.
2. The gift of Christ teaches us that true love is costly.
3. The gift of Christ teaches us that genuine gifts are unearned.
4. The gift of Christ teaches us about the unchanging character of the Gift Giver.
5. The gift of Christ should move us to gratitude.
