The Apostle Paul was faithfully following the Lord's directive for his life as the apostle to the Gentiles. He received a letter from Corinth. He responded to that letter with the letter we have been studying called 1st Corinthians. It was a corrective letter and he addressed divisions in the church, immorality, lawsuits, confusion about marriage, divorce, and celibacy, overindulgence, selfishness, lack of concern for the poor, misunderstandings about spiritual gifts, confusion about the resurrection and resurrected bodies, and an overall lack of love. As he was finishing his correspondence, he spoke about the mission he was on. There was a need for resources, execution of orders, and co-laborers for the mission to go well.
