R. Read the Bible. The Bible is our authority. God uses the Bible to nourish us and prepare us for good works. Make it a daily habit. 2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:19-21

E. Eat with others. We always find time to eat around 20 meals a week. When you eat together with someone you build relationship. Look for opportunities to eat with or have a coffee with others inside and outside the church three times a week. Matthew 11:19, Revelation 3:20

A. Acts of Kindness. Jesus said we should love our neighbors as ourselves and that it is more blessed to give than to receive. God has also prepared good works for us to walk in. Bless at least three people each week. Matthew 22:39, Ephesians 2:10, Acts 20:35

C. Consider or think about R.E.A.C.H. daily. Think about what you read and your day. Confess your sins if you've fallen short. Thank God for the victories. Ask yourself if you have been intentional about putting others first and making disciples? Philippians 2:3-11, 1 John 1:9

H. Hear what God and others are saying to you. God instructs us throughout the day. Be sensitive to what He is saying. Also, listen to those who you come across each day. When you listen to them they know you care and you have opportunities to share Christ. John 10:27, Acts 8:26-35

R. READ THE BIBLE | What are you reading this week?

E. EAT WITH OTHERS | Who am I going to eat with this week? (In the church and outside the church.)

A. ACTS OF KINDNESS | Who am I going to bless and how?

C. CONSIDER | When will I take time to reflect on the day with the Lord? What have I learned?

H. HEAR | What has the Lord made clear to me today? Who has He put in my path? Is there follow up needed?

- Ask God to:
 - prepare your heart and change you
 - use you to help others take a step towards love and obedience in Christ
 - give you wisdom about where to sit, who to welcome, listen to, encourage, pray with
